***Texas Construction Announces Best of 2009 Winners
~Two projects tie for prestigious Judges Award ~***

Austin – October 1, 2009 – [Texas Construction](#) magazine is pleased to announce the complete list of winners of its Best of 2009 awards program. The annual competition recognizes commercial construction and design excellence from across the state and this year for the first time including Oklahoma.

An independent jury of industry experts judged more than 150 nominated projects in mid-September. Projects were eligible for the competition if they were 1) located in Texas or Oklahoma; 2) completed in the past year; 3) did not have a construction-related fatality.

The awards listed on the following pages will be featured in the December issue of [Texas Construction](#) and honored at an awards luncheon to be held at the Marriott Las Colinas in Dallas on Tuesday, Dec. 8. All submitting firms and team members are invited to attend.

The jury awarded projects based on entry criteria including safety; innovation; contribution to the community or industry; construction quality and craftsmanship; and function and aesthetic quality of design.

The entries were sorted by project type. Each category has one “Best of” award winner and in some cases one or more awards of “Excellence.” Three new “special” awards were added to this year’s competition. They are for: Best Architectural Design, Best Engineering Design, and Best Project Management.

The “Judges Award,” which determines the most exceptional project, resulted in a tie this year. Five projects were finalists for this award, the competition’s top prize. The nominees—all of which are also award-winner in Best of categories and in some cases “special” awards—were: 1) NRG Cedar Bayou, Baytown; 2) Addition & Renovation of the Historic Cotton Bowl Phase II, Dallas; 3) Texas Children's Hospital Feigin Research Center, Houston; 4) Golden Pass Liquefied Natural Gas Terminal, Sabine Pass; and 5) Remington Medical Resort of San Antonio.

After thoughtful review, the jury named NRG Cedar Bayou, Baytown; and Golden Pass Liquefied Natural Gas Terminal, Sabine Pass, as this year’s two Judges Award winners.

The winners of Texas Construction’s Best of '09, listed on the pages below, will be entered into the National Best of 2009 competition and judged against winners from other regions. Those winners, the National Best of 2009 awards, will be highlighted on texas.construction.com as well an upcoming issue of [Engineering News-Record](#).
